

Conditions of Entry

The competition

- Organizer: The Bodleian Libraries of the University of Oxford, Broad Street, Oxford, OX1 3BG, United Kingdom (the "Bodleian Libraries").
- The competition 'Win a Tolkien book' is managed by the Bodleian Libraries.
- Competition entry is free.

General terms

- Competition entrants, by entering, agree to abide by the rules of the competition.
- Details of how to enter your submission form part of the competition rules.
- The organizer reserves the right at any time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the competition with or without prior notice due to reasons outside its control including, without limitation, in the case of anticipated, suspected or actual fraud.
- The competition and the competition rules will be governed by English law.

Eligibility

- Entrants (and anyone else who appears in any visual material contained in the entry) must be 18 years or over.
- The competition is not open to employees of the Bodleian Libraries or their family members, or anyone else professionally associated with the competition. Any such person may submit a non-competitive entry which may be exhibited although will not be eligible for any prize.

Submitting an entry

- Participants will be asked to submit one answer through the online form.
- Participants should also submit their name and email address.
- Entry will be via the online form on the Bodleian's Tolkien website.
- All online entries should include one answer to the question.

Key dates

- 30 September 2018: deadline for submission of online entry form.
- 5 October 2018: the winner will be notified by this date.

Acceptable content and judging criteria

- The winning correct submission will be selected at random.
- The organizer reserves the right to disqualify submissions if the content is considered inappropriate or offensive, or is not relevant to the subject of the competition.
- The organizer reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual that corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition.

Closing date, notification and prize

- All entries must be received by midnight on 30 September 2018. Entries received after that date and time will not be considered.
- The organizer's decision on all matters relating to the competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the judging and organisation of the competition.
- The prize is a Tolkien: Maker of Middle-earth catalogue signed by all its contributors.

Liability

- The organizer reserves the right to withdraw or amend the competition without notice as necessary.
- The organizer accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered, entered or viewed for any technical or other reason.
- The organizer accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by entrants as a result of entering the competition or accepting the prize.
- The organizer shall not be responsible for any failure to comply with its obligations where the failure is caused by reasons outside its reasonable control.
